Objections

Call me back later and we will see: Thank you so much for agreeing to help me out! I know <u>Sally</u> said you were nice, but she didn't tell me you were this nice! It would be amazing if we could set up a time right now and pencil it in and then I will call you to confirm because I REALLY need to have my schedule booked to stay on track towards my goals. Do you want to pencil in <u>Day</u> at <u>Time</u> or do you think <u>Time</u> would be better ... if you had to guess?

How long does it take? 4-5 hours Ill bring my sleeping bag just in case! (JK) Maybe an hour or so, but not too long because I am REALLY busy and I'll keep it as quick as possible so I can just get credit towards the scholarship. So could you squeeze me in real quick at or would be better?
